


The Problem

While colleges have sought to reduce barriers to students, they are frequently criticized as drivers of inequality, with low and middle income students being left behind by an increasingly complex system that favors those who can afford personalized help.

Regardless of their socioeconomic status, students are let down and left behind by a system that favors the kind of one size fits all advice pushed by the college admissions industry and an overwhelmed guidance infrastructure where the average counsellor is advising over 400 students of vastly different needs, strengths and goals.

With administration budgets already stretched thin, schools are unable to provide the kind of one to one mentoring that makes a real difference in students' lives and greatly improves outcomes. The vastly different schools, programs and majors that students apply to makes it incredibly difficult to find informed mentors who can provide guidance from first hand experience. The internet should solve this problem, but has yet to.

Through a platform connecting students to mentors who were in their place just a few years before, Squired connects students with experienced mentors for one-to-one guidance from people who understand and share their interests, strengths and goals. That personalized mentoring allows applicants to get world class admissions help at a small fraction of the cost of traditional college consultants.



What is Squired?

Squired connects students applying to competitive universities with mentors who have been through the process themselves, to offer help and advice with the college application process.


Features of Squired include:

- Mentors offer essay editing, feedback, interview prep, and guidance from first hand experience at a rate significantly below traditional college consultants.
- Students can see Mentors' profiles, essays, and stats to match with mentors with similar interests, strengths and goals.
- Mentoring sessions are enabled through a 2-way approval scheduling system over video chat, offering students world class application advice no matter where they live, which school they go to, or who they know

Our Story

Squired was born out of a frustration with the lack of transparency and accessibility to quality information on the college application process throughout our own college application experiences. In 2016, we launched IvyApps.org. The site offered free profiles, essays and written advice from successful applicants to top universities, giving every student a chance to see inside the application process. Since then, IvyApps has grown to reach over 150,000 students across the US and 183 other countries worldwide. As we grew, students came to us to ask about connecting directly with mentors featured for one-to-one help, while students who had used the site to get into college came back to offer their own essays and help.

In June of this year we launched the Squired platform to bridge that gap: connecting students seeking help with those most able to provide it.



Value Proposition

Benefits of Squired include:

- Personal: Squired enables personal connections between students and mentors.
 Our detailed profiles and essays allow students to get to know mentors on the platform before booking or getting in touch.
- Affordable: Squired's mentors are students themselves, and offer mentoring at a price significantly below traditional college consultants. Furthermore, our online only model and use of content marketing allows us to eliminate nearly all of the costs associated with in person college consulting and tutoring services. Our unique model of shareable user generated content allows us to bring in targeted traffic interested in our Mentors without any ad spend.
- Accessible: Squired is entirely online, allowing students and parents to access our platform regardless of where they live, who they know, or where they go to school.
